We are glad to be able to offer scholarship funds for Cambridge youth looking to attend BB&N summer camps this year. ## How to apply for scholarship funds to attend BB&N Summer Camps:

- Scholarships are available for all BB&N camps (all types and weeks).
- Look at the BB&N summer website to choose which camp weeks (classic or speciality camps) you would like your child to attend. For all camps, families register & pay by the week, even if your child will be going for multiple weeks.
- Consider how much your family can afford to pay towards the cost of BB&N camp. All families are required to pay \$55 per week, but you can apply for scholarship funding to cover all other costs. Extended day and transportations costs are in addition to the camp tuition and can be requested to be covered by scholarship as well. (The \$55/week doesn't need to be paid until after you hear back from us about scholarship funding, when you register your child on the website)
- Fill out the form below with your scholarship funding request and the amount that your family is able to pay towards camp. Forms can be mailed (see address below) or emailed. If it is easier, you can copy the questions into an email, add your responses and send that to <a href="mailto:dbonilla@cpsd.us">dbonilla@cpsd.us</a>

- When you hear back from the scholarship committee (either by April 9th or May 21st depending on when you submit the request), go ahead and register your child for camp on the Summer BB&N website (this is when you pay the \$55/week).
- Contact us if you'd like to do the online registration process with someone on the phone it is extensive and requires many documents.
- If you are receiving a partial scholarship (i.e. your family is paying \$100/week) all other payments to BB&N must be made by June 1st.
- After that, all communication about camp will go through BB&N enjoy the summer!

**Timing of when to apply for funding:** Applications (this form) will be reviewed twice:

- Apply by **April 2nd** if you need to hear about scholarship funding by April 9th.
- May 14th applicants will hear about scholarship funding by May 21st.

**Who can apply:** Scholarship assistance is awarded based on need, and priority goes to young people attending CPS schools, although youth attending other schools are still welcome to apply.

When you will hear back: Families will be contacted one week after those dates (so by April 9th or May 21st) about awards and can then register on <a href="BB&N summer website">BB&N summer website</a> (this is when families pay their \$55 registration fee). If needed, a final round will be reviewed June 1st, although funding may be depleted based on the number of applicants already received and funded. If you are interested in this camp and scholarship and it is after May 14th (but before camp begins) you can still reach out to see if there is funding available. Please contact us directly through the contact info listed below. If you would need scholarship funding to be applied towards the extended day and transportation fees, please note that below.
